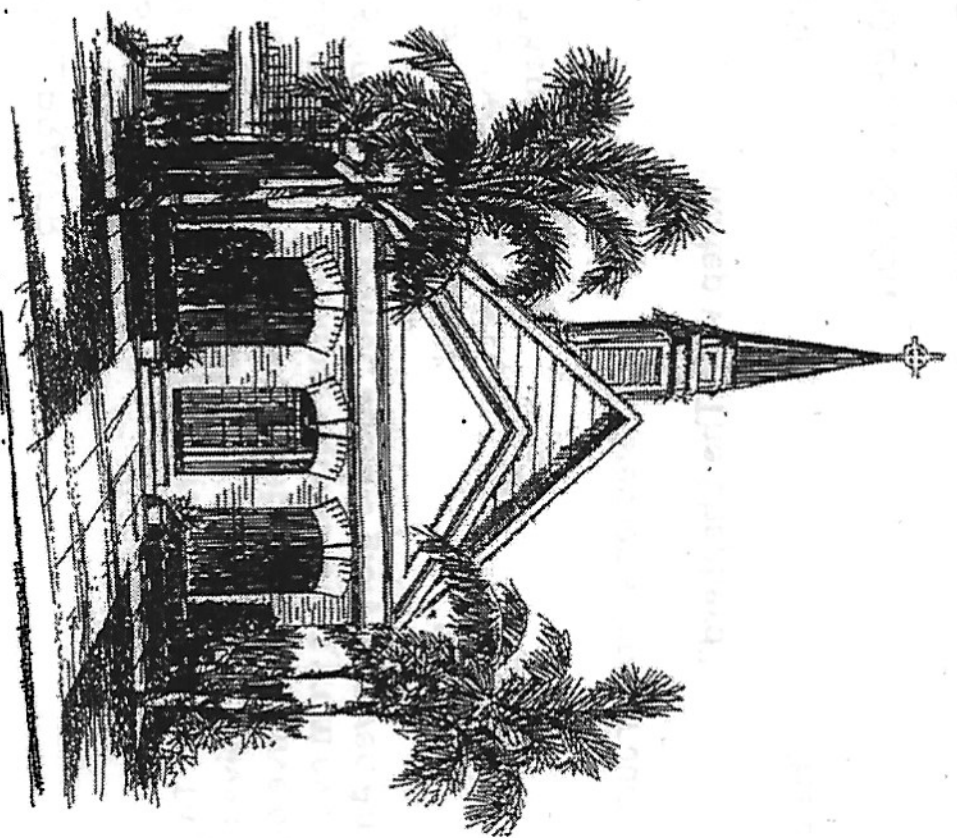

ANNOUNCEMENTS, January 28, 2024

GUEST PREACHER TODAY: Pastor Paul will be out of town on an assignment for the Presbytery today and has asked **Judy Doverspike**, trained as a **Stephen's minister**, to fill in for him and share her message today. She rejoices in this opportunity to share her love of God and the Church with us.

WHAT IS A STEPHEN MINISTER? The Stephen Ministry was founded in 1975. Stephen Ministers are members of a congregation specially trained to provide care, encouragement and spiritual support to others.

WHY THE NAME STEPHEN? During the time of the early church, the apostles decided to choose among their faithful disciples those who would be sent into the community to minister to the needs of the people. "And they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit." (Acts 6:5). You will find the story of Stephen in the book of Acts, Chapters 6 and 7.

OFFERTORY ENVELOPE BOXES AVAILABLE FOR 2024

These Individual boxes of offertory envelopes contain an Offering Envelope for each Sunday of the year, plus envelopes for special Sundays and an envelope for the **Per Capita payment** required by the Presbytery of each active member of the church.

It is hoped that all church members, and friends of the church who attend services on a regular basis, will choose to use these envelopes during the year.

Per Capita payment: Our church, with an official active membership of 68 as of January 1, 2023, must pay **\$2,505.80**. This amounts to **\$36.85 per active member of HSCPC**

THANK YOU to the 24 members who have paid their Per

Capita fee. However, we have 68 active members, which means that 44 members {65%} have yet to pay this fee. If they don't pay it, their portion of the Per Capita fee (\$1,624) will have to come out of the church treasury. Checks for **\$36.85** should be made payable to Hobe Sound Community Presbyterian Church.
