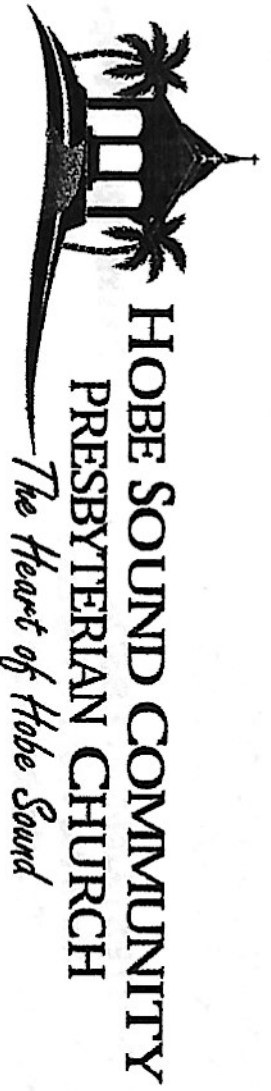

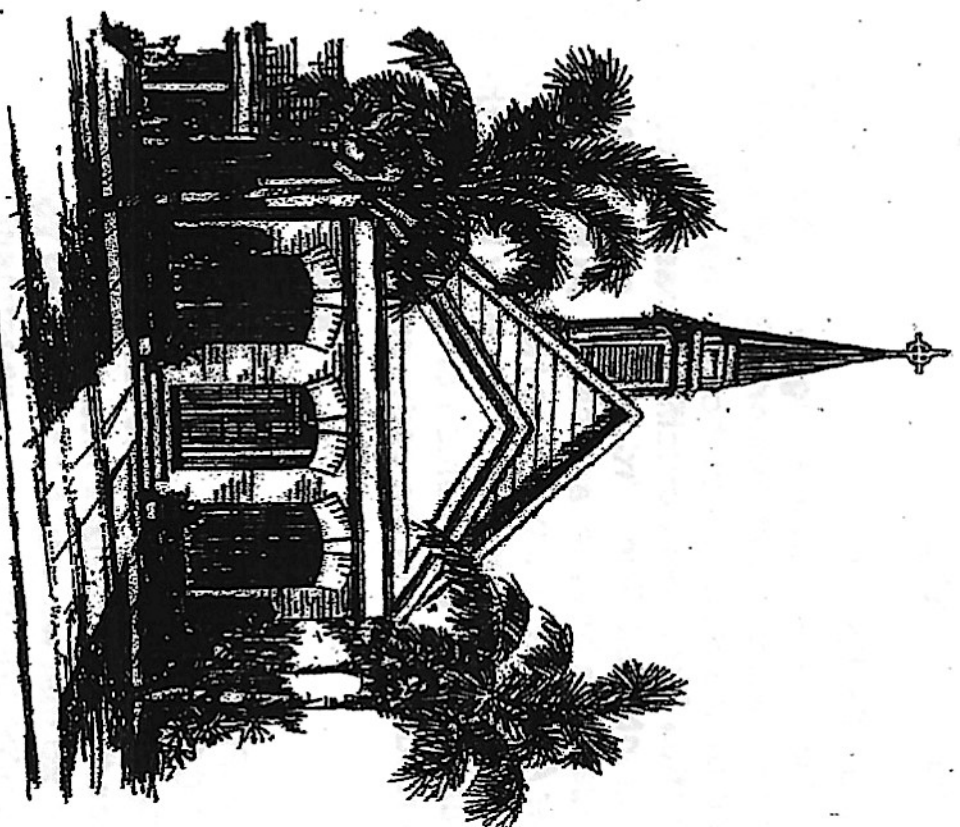

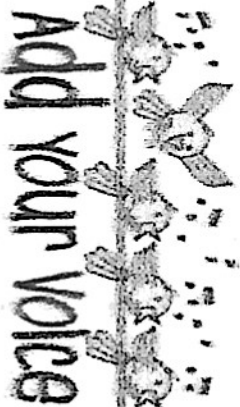
Please note: **Debra** will be out of town for a while, so art classes are cancelled until **October 1**
