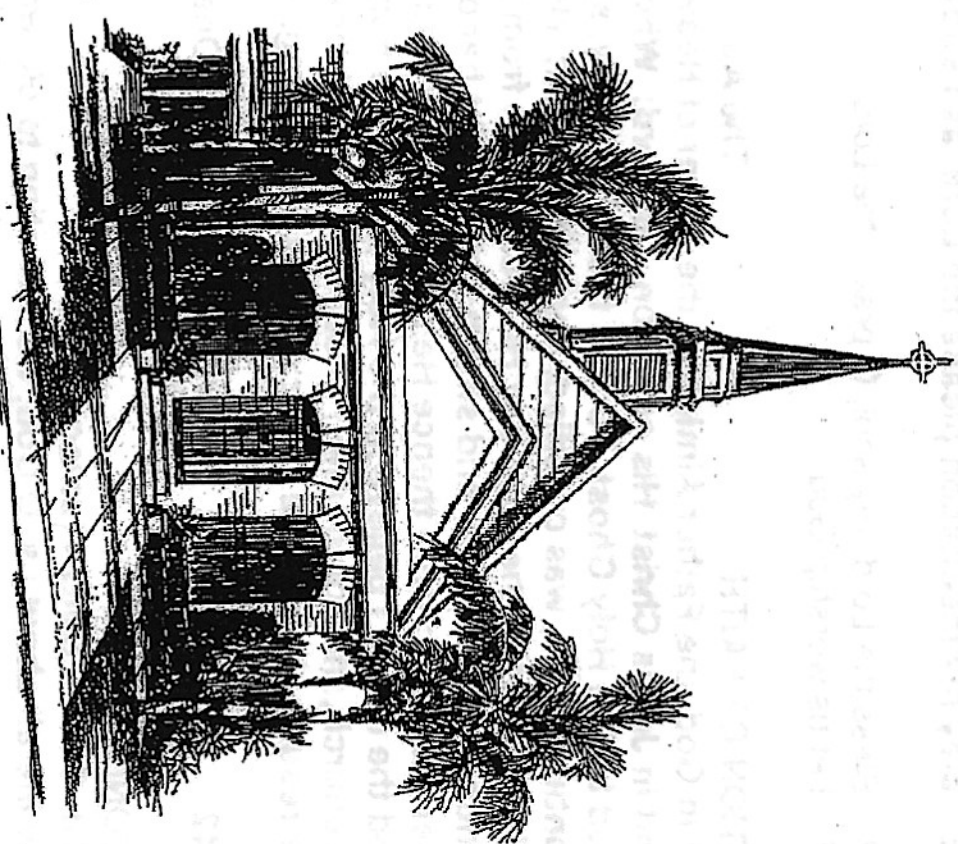

ANNOUNCEMENTS, June 8, 2025

TODAY IS PENTECOST SUNDAY

Pentecost is observed on the seventh Sunday after Easter. It celebrates the blessing of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus Christ, as mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2:1-31).

The description in Acts 2 states that, after Jesus ascended into heaven, Jesus' followers were gathered together for the Feast of Harvest, and the Holy Spirit "filled the whole house where they were sitting" (Acts 2:2). "All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them" (Acts 2:4). This unusual event drew a large crowd, and Peter stood up to speak to them about repentance and the gospel of Christ (Acts 2:14). By the end of the day that the Holy Spirit came, the Church grew by 3,000 people (Acts 2:41).

The liturgical color for Pentecost is red. It is customary that worshippers on Pentecost Sunday wear something red when they attend their worship service.
