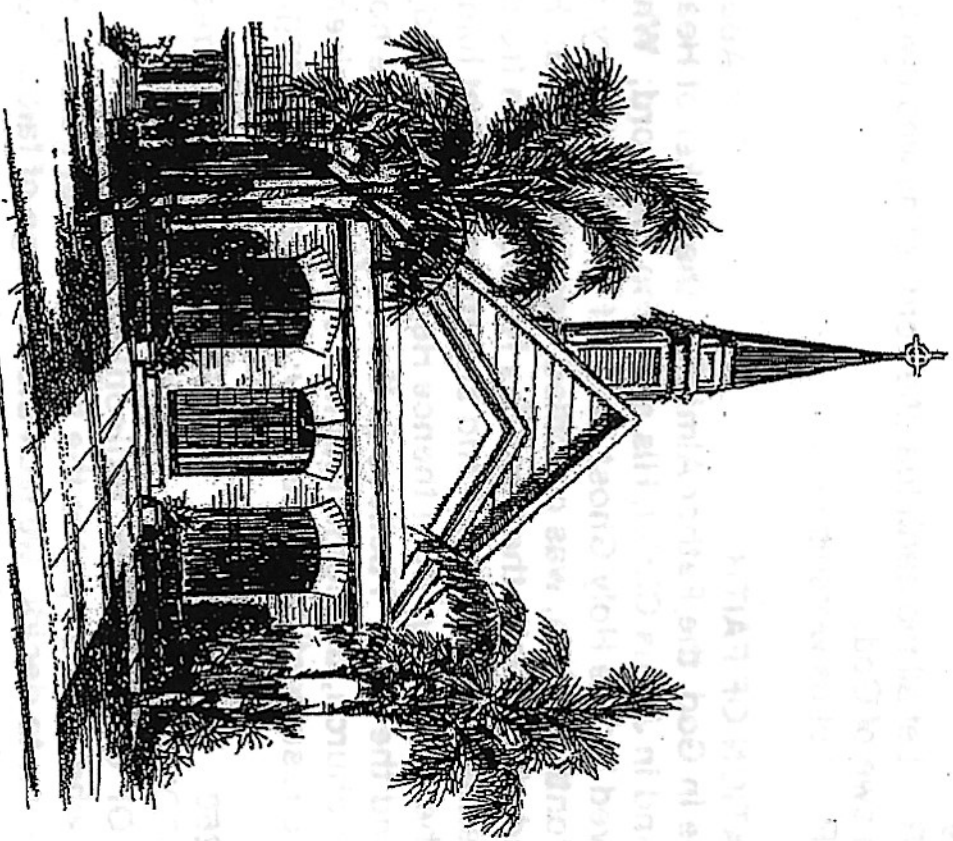

TRINITY SUNDAY

and the

LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The “**SEASON OF PENTECOST**” started last week; 50 days after Easter when the Holy Spirit descended upon the 12 disciples. Pentecost season lasts until Advent, including a few special Sundays. Just as we celebrate on Pentecost the coming of the Holy Spirit, the third element of the Trinity, the Pentecost Season recognizes God moving in our lives, empowering us and motivating us to spread his love and message. From this Sunday on, the liturgical color will be green and will be reflected in the paraments on the pulpit and the pastor's stoles. It is the longest season of the church, as we move into ordinary time and hear the lessons of Jesus' teachings and learn how to live the Christian life.

Today is “**TRINITY SUNDAY**”. We proclaim the mystery of our faith in the triune God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, One-in-Three and Three-In-One. Unlike other festivals in the church's liturgical calendar, Trinity Sunday centers on a doctrine of the church, rather than an event.
