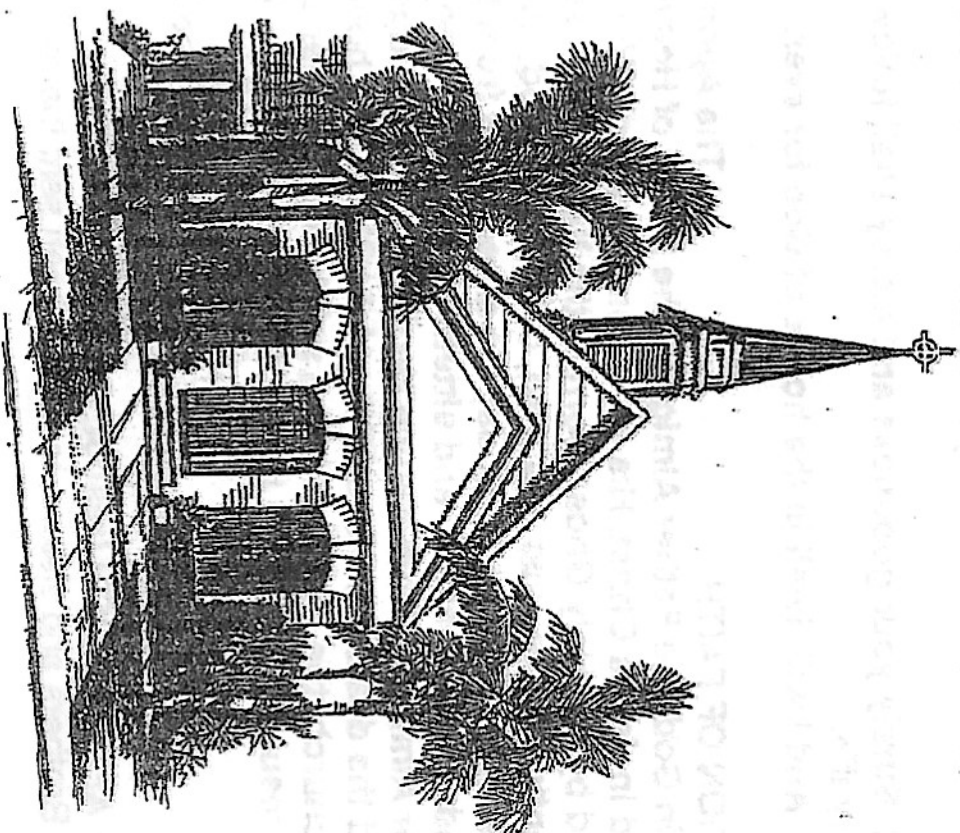

DID YOU KNOW? A little Mother's Day history

Mother's Day in the United States has its roots in love, remembrance and a desire to honor our mothers personally, not commercially. In 1908, wanting to honor her own mother, who created "Mothers' Work Clubs" for health and peace, Anna Jarvis originally envisioned the day as a time for personal sentiment rather than profit and by 1914 Congress passed a resolution declaring the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day. But by 1925 she became distraught by how quickly florists and card companies commercialized the holiday and she spent the rest of her life trying to abolish the holiday she created. ❀ ❀
