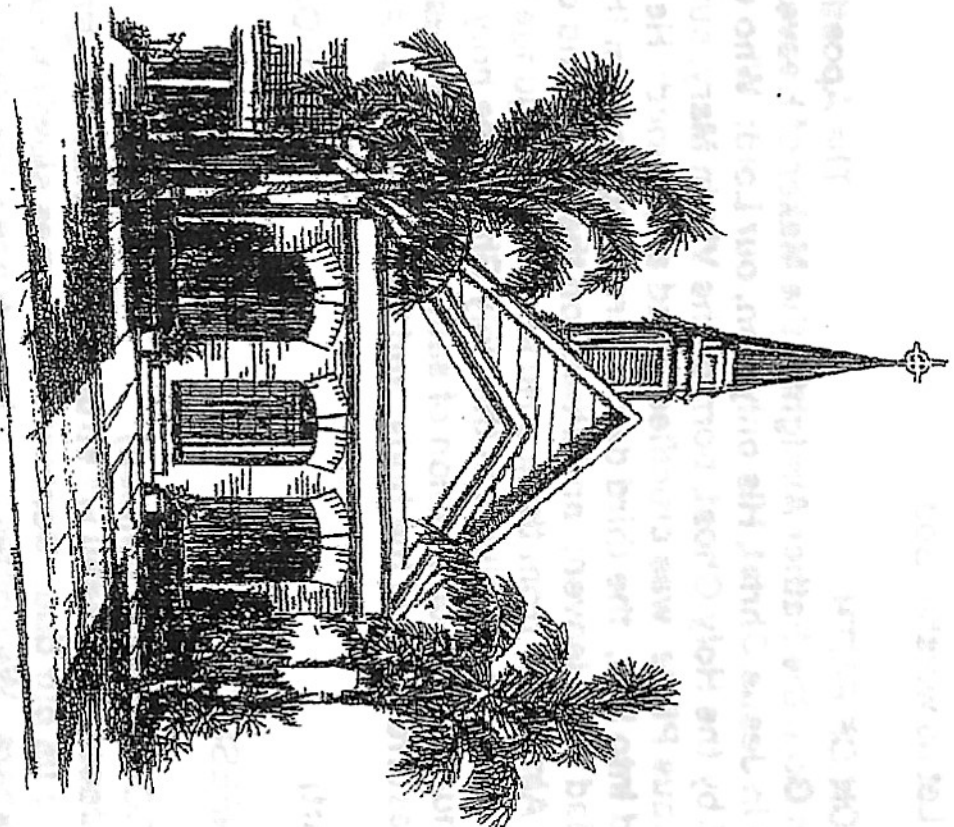

## MISSION OPPORTUNITIES

**Cathy Brooks**, A friend of our church and a member of the Barn Artists, is in need of rides for appointments and treatments at Jupiter Medical Center. She lost her right arm to cancer several years ago, and has had additional medical issues since that time. **Art Ondtch** is compiling a list of people who would be able to help her out with rides on an as available basis. **Luis Flores** is a young boy in Nicaragua, born with a severe defect in his right leg. Following amputation of his leg at 18 months of age, Luis was fitted with his first prosthesis at age 2. But, the prosthesis doesn't grow with the growing child, so a new one is needed every couple of years until Luis reaches his adult height.

Since 2020, through Christmas and Easter Mission offerings, HSCPC members and friends have helped with the considerable expenses required to adjust and replace the prosthesis as needed. Luis is now 14 years old and in need of a new prosthesis. The cost of the new prosthesis is \$3,000, and with a family income of just \$500/month it would be impossible to achieve without help.
