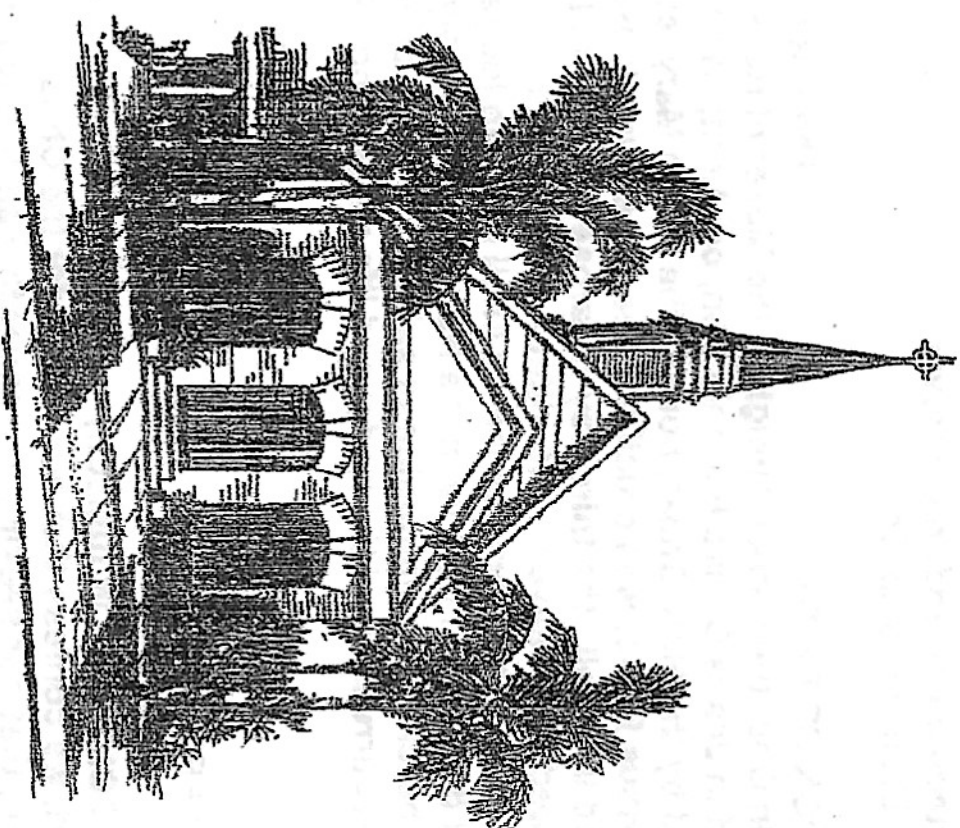

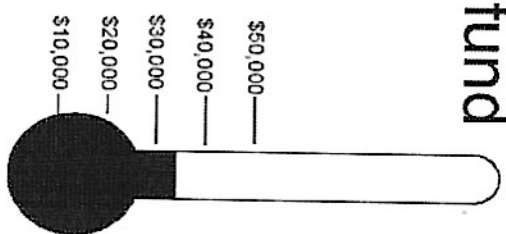

MATCHING CHALLENGE

A generous donor has offered to match all contributions to the church building fund dollar for dollar up to \$100,000.

As of Thursday, August 27, a total of \$32,810 has been received and credited to the challenge grant.



The Fine Print

Every donation to the church building fund is eligible for matching. Donations must be received by October 1 to be matched.

There is no limit to individual donations to be matched.

Individuals can make more than one donation.

Members and Non-Members can donate.

Estimates for the church's new roof, including rebuilding the covered walkway to current building codes are in the \$300,000 range. As of today, the building fund has \$100,000 in the account. With this matching opportunity we will have the funds necessary to complete the entire roof project provided we match the \$100,000 completely. No amount is too little to match and no amount is too great.
